IT'S YOUR SHUL – HELP US TAKE PROPER CARE OF IT.

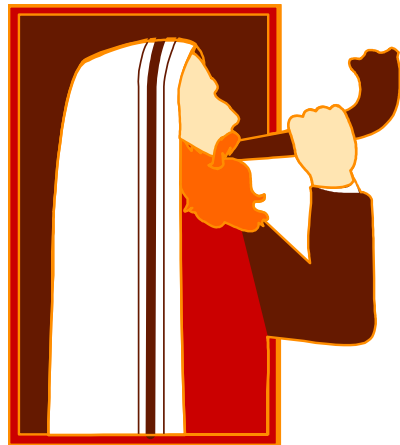

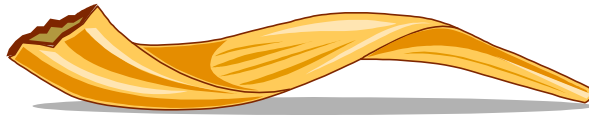
