Annual Yom Hashoah Program - Monday, April 28, 7:30 PM at KMS. The featured speaker is Mr. Leon Merrick. Leon Merrick was born in Poland in 1926. After the Nazi invasion of Poland, Leon and his family were moved into the Lodz ghetto in 1940. After four years in the ghetto, he survived forced labor in Poland, and was then moved to the Buchenwald and Flossenbürg concentration camps. As the Allies approached, Mr. Merrick was sent on a death march until he was liberated by the Americans on April 23, 1945. Shortly afterward, Leon immigrated to the United States, and served in the US Army. Leon's wife, Nina, is also a Holocaust survivor. Children grade 5 and older are encouraged to attend.
