Rabbi Dovid Rosenbaum has been elected as Rabbi with 92% of the votes cast, which is more than the 60% required by the YISE Constitution.

The next step will be contract negotiations with Rabbi Rosenbaum. The Board approved a Rabbinic Contract Negotiating Committee at the last Board Meeting. The members of the Committee are Arnie Sherman (chair), David Hornestay and Manasseh Katz. The Committee will negotiate a contract with Rabbi Rosenbaum and submit it to the Board for approval.
