**Annual YISE/KMS Holocaust Memorial Program** – Sunday, April 22, 7:30 pm at KMS. Nine year old Bertha Schwarz and her 6 year old sister were placed on a bus in Vichy, France by their mother in the summer of 1942, in an attempt to send the girls to relative safety. Rabbi Zalman Shneerson, a Jewish rescuer who ran homes for Jewish orphans, found the girls and provided them with food and comfort.
