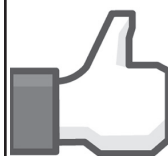

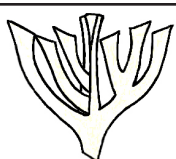
YISE Financial Software Conversion and Statements

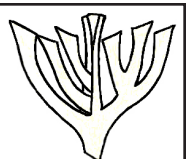
