Annual income limits to qualify for childcare tuition assistance via Maryland's Child Care Subsidy (CCS) Program have increased dramatically as of August 1. A family of 4, for example, now qualifies for financial assistance with a maximum annual income of \$71,525, while a family of 6 must make less than \$94,413.
