ABOUT 100 JEWS WERE KILLED THAT NIGHT. IN THE AFTERMATH OF KRISTALLNACHT, ABOUT 30,000 JEWISH MEN WERE ARRESTED AND SENT TO CONCENTRATION CAMPS. CONDITIONS FOR JEWS IN GERMANY AFTER KRISTALLNACHT BECAME INCREASINGLY WORSE. BY 1945, SOME 6 MILLION JEWS ACROSS EUROPE WERE KILLED.*
