Born in Vienna, in 1928, Edith and her family were forced to flee before the war. It was in France that her brother and father were deported to Auschwitz, never to return. She and her mother lived in a farming village until she needed to hide with false papers provided by the Jewish Scouts of France. She and her mother survived the war, but lived under harsh conditions in Toulouse, where Edith studied at the university. Eventually, after arriving in New York, Edith married, had three children, and became a Professor of languages. She wrote the book: BECOMING EDITH: THE EDUCATION OF A HIDDEN CHILD, published also in French in 2013.
